### **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS and CARERS**

**SUMMIT SCHOOL OF JUDO** expects that parents/carers will

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them.
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials.
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
- Never force your child to take part in sport.
- Set a good example by recognising fair play & applauding good performances of all.
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
- Publicly accept officials' judgements.
- Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
- Use correct and proper language at all times.
- Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.

### **CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS (INCLUDING REFEREES, OFFICIALS AND ALL OTHER VOLUNTEERS)**

Members of **SUMMIT SCHOOL OF JUDO** are expected to abide by the following code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background or religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach. Members should NOT wear suits outside of the Dojo unless covered by a tracksuit,
- No Footwear to be worn on the mat, Footwear is to be worn at all times off the mat.
- Members must pay any fees for training or events promptly
- Members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not allowed to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs (apart from medicinal drugs) whilst practising and other **SUMMIT SCHOOL OF JUDO** Activities (coaching, training etc).

Be polite to other people
- COURAGE**  
Face difficulty without fear
- FAIRPLAY**  
Be a good sport, play by the rules
- HONOUR**  
Fairness in beliefs and actions
- MODESTY**  
Be without vanity or boastfulness
- RESPECT**  
Regard for others
- SELF-CONTROL**  
Control over yourself and actions
- FRIENDSHIP**  
Be a good friend, be helpful and kind
- HYGIENE**  
Wear a clean judogi. No shoes on the mat. Zoris worn off the mat.
